

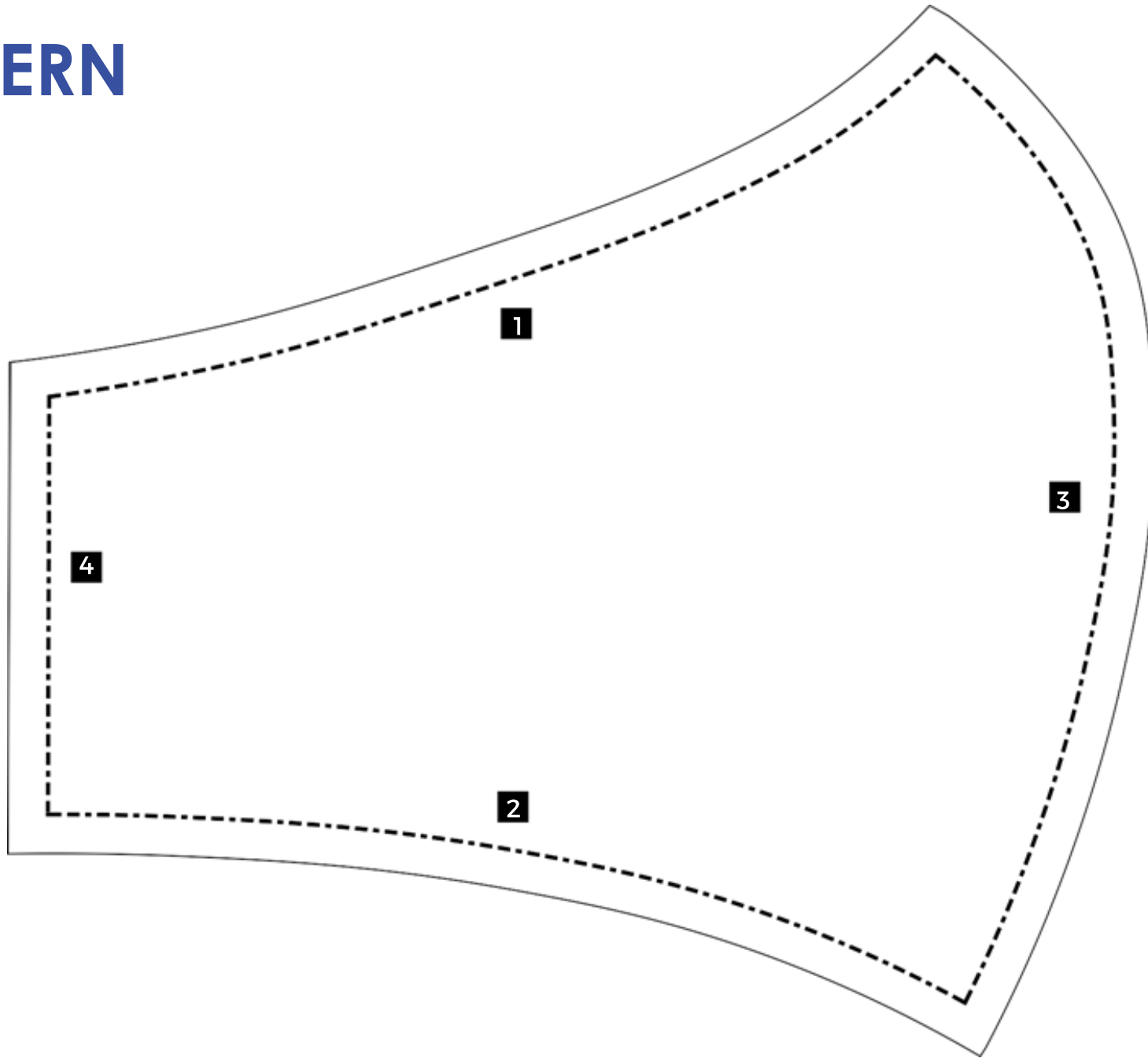
# DIY MASK GUIDE | STYLE 1



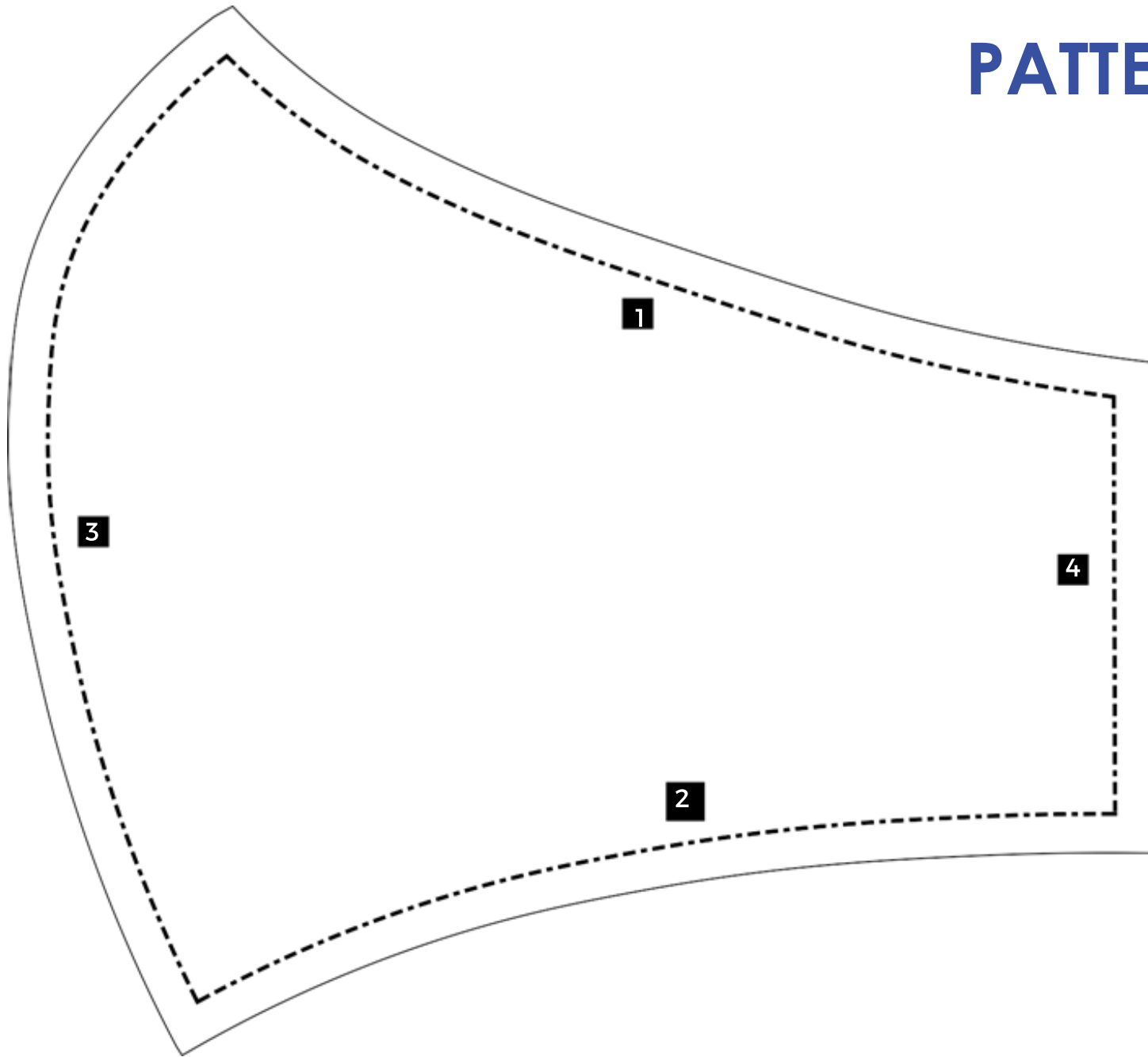
## MATERIALS

- Tea cloth & 100% cotton fabric or backings of two 100% cotton fabrics (-1/2 yard is enough to make 2-3 masks)
- Pellon interfacing fabric for filter (encouraged but not required)
- All-purpose thread
- Form of elastic (7in) or hair ties
- Garden wire or plastic covered wire (like a twist tie)
- Scissors

# INSTRUCTIONS

- 1** Using the patterns, cut one of each shape. You will need four total pieces.
- 2** Sew face 1 and face 2 together along side 3.
- 3** Sew mouth 1 and mouth 2 together along side 3.
- 4** Place the wire on the inside of the top of mouth 1 where the bridge of the nose would be. Sew the wire to the fabric.
- 5** With the fronts of the fabric facing each other, sew along the entire perimeter of the mask, but leaving one end (side 4) open.
- 6** You will now flip the mask inside out using the opening.
- 7** Now place the elastic on the edge of the mask. Fold the fabric over the elastic and sew.
- 8** Your mask is finished!
